Casey is passionate about sports conditioning and working with athletes to get them back to their top performance.

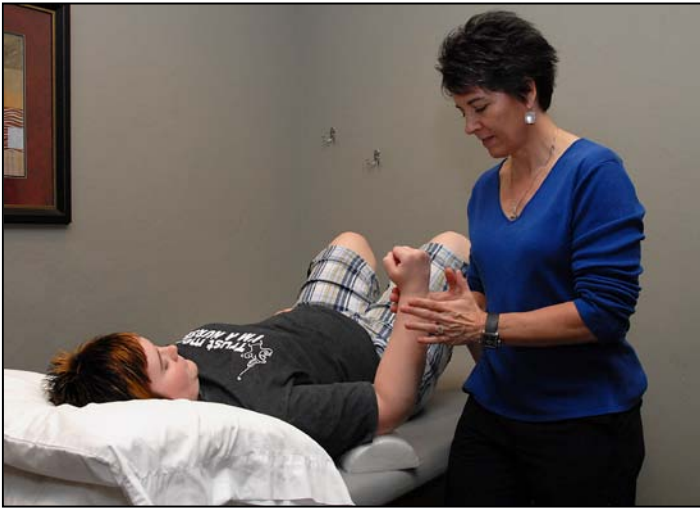

- He enjoys spending time with his family, riding his bike, working with horses, hunting and fishing. Casey and Heather just welcomed Bodee Kirkes to their family.



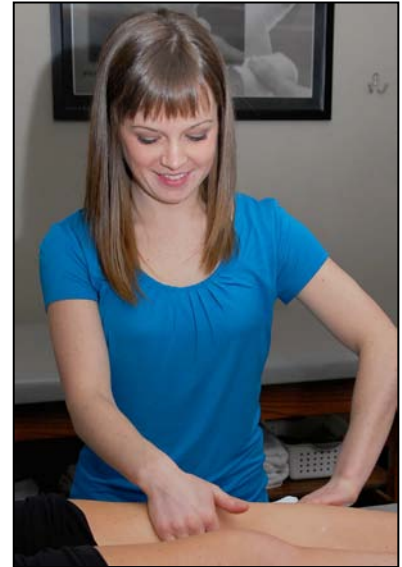
### **Did You Know ?**
